Wohlsen Construction Company Receives Seven Awards

Wohlsen Construction Company received seven awards from the Keystone Chapter of Associated Builders and Contractors (ABC) at the association's recent 18th Annual Excellence in Construction Awards Gala.

The Administrative Center for York County received a first place Award of Excellence. The award was received in the Renovation over \$3 million category. The adaptive reuse and historic rehabilitation project consisted of 133,000 square feet of renovations and 3,000 square feet of new construction. The building was designed and constructed to be LEED Certified by the U.S. Green Building Council.

An Award of Excellence in the Renovation \$1 – 3 million category was received for the Houlihan's Restaurant constructed in Hershey, PA for Hershey Entertainment and Resort Company. The project included the fit-out of 8,300 square feet located on the first floor of the historic Hershey Press Building in downtown Hershey, Pa.

Wohlsen received a third Award of Excellence in the Institutional Under \$2 million category for the Joseph International House constructed on the campus of Franklin and Marshall College, located in Lancaster, Pa. The 3,660 square foot 2-story academic building was constructed on the College's occupied campus Lancaster, Pa.

An award of merit in the Miscellaneous / Special Projects category was received for the construction of an enclosed Japanese Garden located adjacent to the Joseph International Center at Franklin and Marshall College.

The Reading Hospital and Medical Center Beginnings Maternity Center Phase One Renovation project received an award of merit in the Renovation over \$3 million category.

The Oncology Treatment Building on the campus of the Milton S. Hershey Medical Center received an award of merit in the Institutional \$2 – 10 million category.

Wohlsen's fourth award of merit was also in the Institutional \$2 – 10 million category for the St. Peter's Evangelical Lutheran Church new sanctuary project, located in Lancaster, Pa.
